- 1. This competition is open to all ALBASA member institutions of Visayas and Mindanao Regions, book exhibitors and publishers.
- 2. Participants are classified into four (4) groups as follows:

Visayas Group

Mindanao Group

Cebu Group

Book Exhibitors Group

- 3. Each group shall be composed of a maximum of ten (10) participants.
- 4. The participants shall perform Philippine folk dances identified by the ALBASA BOT. These include:
 - a. Itik-Itik
 - b. Kuratsa
 - c. Manang Biday
 - d. Subli
- 5. Drawing of lots for dance assignments will be done during the Business Meeting to give ample time for the group to gather and practice.
- 6. Music in USB of the assigned dance will be provided by the Committee. All USB's should be returned to ALBASA after the presentation/program.
- 7. Presentation will be on the Fellowship night of May 15, 2014.
- 8. The group is expected to be at the Fellowship venue an hour before the program starts. It is the group's responsibility to turn in the music to the sound technician before the competition.
- 9. The Criteria for Judging are as follows:

Choreography /Creativity	30%
Performance (stage presence,	40%
confidence and projection)	
Appropriateness of Costumes and Props	20%
Audience Impact	10%
